If the 3721 Republicans in Crown Heights (Col 2) had registered as Democrats to vote in Democratic primaries, NYS Sen Zellnor Myrie and US Rep Yvette Clarke would have lost their primaries due to the Jewish “swing vote” surpassing the Margin of Victory (Col 7). Even if unregistered voters voted 100% Republican, there was no chance the Republican candidates could have achieved enough winning votes to win the General Elections (Col 9). Also, Conservative (Col 3), Independence(Col 4) & unregistered (Col 5) voters should, with Republicans (Col 2), **register as Democrats** to form a Swing vote that can exceed democratic primary Margin of Victory.
