# Famiiiiiiiiiiiiiiiiilly Profile *The Friedman Family*

**How many boys do you have in Oholei Torah?**  
We currently have two boys in Oholei Torah.

**What ages and which grades are they in**  
Moshe, our oldest, is 11 and is in 5th grade.  
Menachem is 4 and is in kindergarten.

**Where did you grow up and go to school?**  
Mr. Friedman: I grew up in Montreal and went to Yeshivas Tomchei Tmimim Montreal.

**How would you describe you and your boys' Oholei Torah experience?**  
Although, Oholei Torah is a large school with such large student body, the school successfully managed to tailor the educational experience so that our children feel a personal level of care and attention. Our children are receiving a strong education, building lasting friendships and experiencing the unique "chayus" that Oholei Torah is so famous for.

**How has Yeshiva (and חינוך) changed over the years?**

It seems there has been a noticeable shift toward strong curriculum-based education that has really paid off in the knowledge and skills our children display. The increased effort the school is making to work with children of varying levels of engagement and learning, as well as strengthening the school's mental health resources so that children gain the confidence and tools to succeed both in and out of school are wonderful. It makes me wonder what the current landscape would look like had our schools had these resources growing up.

**Describe Oholei Torah in one word.**  
"HAPPENING."

## *When were you born and where did you grow up?*

I was born and bred in Crown Heights.

## *When did you first come to Oholei Torah and how many years did you spend ?*

I was in Oholei Torah from preschool in 1982 through the first year of Bais Medrash. I clearly remember my preschool teachers: Morah Hecht ה"ע and א"ר תבלחט" Morah Faige Winner-Hertzl and Morah Pessy.Schapiro.

## *What are your favorite memories of Oholei Torah?*

One outstanding memory I have is of a trip to the country that Rabbi Levi Borenstein gave us a prize. It was planned months in advance and we worked very hard for a long time to earn it.

## *What do you do today?*

I am an accountant and live in Pomona, NY.

## *How has Oholei Torah influenced your way of living, thinking, achieving?*

The education and Chassidische chinuch that I had from my Rebbeim in Oholei Torah definitely had and continues to have an impact on my life, both in what I know and how I act and how I interact with others.

## *Describe Oholei Torah in one word.*

## **אחריות**

Here' an example of learning Achrayus in Oholei Torah: I clearly remember the snowstorm of 1996, when there was approximately 24 inches of snow that crippled the whole city. I was in Bais Medrash at the time. The snow started in the middle of the day and by the time I came back to night seder after eating supper at home, there was already a foot of snow on the ground, and a walk that would usually take ten minutes, took between 30 and 40 minutes. I walked into Bais Medrash and R' Piekarski was sitting near the door. He looked at his watch and said 'Mr. Glick, you're late.'" and he let me into Zal. He didn't reprimand or punish me, but just stated a fact; Years later, as a grown bochur and as a father myself, I thought about it and I still think about it to this day. Rabbi Piekarski taught me a very powerful lesson that afternoon - the responsibility of being on time.
